But try mentioning murder for attempting to participate in a UPR and you'll be voted out-of-order.

The NGOs scheduled to speak after me in Israel's UPR include those known for their racial intolerance. NGOs who don't know and don't care what it means for every Jewish child in Israel to have to spend years of their young lives in the armed forces facing life-and-death situations because threatened extermination is still Israel's reality, and genocide still the goal of so-called Palestinian peace partners.

Today, this Council demonizes Israel for the umpteenth time. Tomorrow this Council will adopt 5 resolutions condemning only Israel, and nothing on Council members Saudi Arabia, Russia or China. This isn't human rights. It's discrimination. Antisemitism – UN-style.
